MOTION FOR TWO-WEEK EXTENSION TO RESPOND

IN THE MATTER OF: TINA PETERS

Conferral under C.R.C.P. 121 § 15-8

The undersigned counsel has conferred with the Complainant and she does not opposed to the relief sought.

1. On January 19, 2022, the Colorado Independent Ethics Commission (“IEC”) sent their Complaint to Ms. Tina Peters (“Peters”) care of the undersigned counsel.
2. Peters’ response is due February 18, 2022.
3. Peters’ counsel has not been able to fully prepare a response for two reasons. First, counsel was unable to focus on work during the latter half of January and beginning of February, due to a Covid infection. And he faced multiple court deadlines in early and mid-February in other matters, including preparation and participation in oral argument before the Commission in Complaint 21-18. For these reasons, undersigned counsel requests a two-week extension of time, to and including March 4, 2022, to file a response.
4. The complainant in this matter does not oppose the request for relief, and no party will be prejudiced by this short extension.

FOR THESE REASONS, the court should grant Tina Peters a short two-week extension to file her response to the IEC's Complaint until March 4, 2022, and also grant the parties all such further relief as is just, proper or appropriate.
