# ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME

At its meeting on August 20, 2024, and due to the then-recent criminal conviction of the Respondent in the above-captioned cases, the Commission instructed its staff to correspond with the parties and solicit feedback about whether the then-existing stays in these cases should be extended through any future criminal appeals. Commission staff corresponded with the parties on August 23, 2024, inviting the parties to brief the issue. Briefs were due on September 13, 2024.
